

PARKS, RECREATION & PUBLIC PROPERTY COMMITTEE MEETING

The following persons were present for the meeting: Committee Members Ron Enyeart and Jim Bair; President Dave Quarry, Councilmembers John Gradwell, Donna Isenberg and James Decker, Sr., Junior Councilperson Madison Troha, Mayor DeeDee Brown, and Borough Manager William W. Wheeler.

Councilperson Enyeart called the meeting to order. Chairperson Houck was not present.

RECOGNIZE GUESTS AND PUBLIC COMMENT: Councilperson Gradwell asked if there was an update available on the Mural at Weaver Park at the Weis Store. Junior Councilperson Troha gave an update. She reported that she has an artist from Juniata College and a group of kids wanting to help. She is waiting for information from Weis. Councilperson Gradwell reported that the contact representative from Weis asked that the color scheme and the picture be approved through them.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Brown did not have a report.

OLD BUSINESS:

250th CELEBRATION UPDATE: Councilperson Enyeart reported that the 250th Celebration committee is having problems getting volunteers. It was suggested that they asked volunteers 70 years old and up.

PARKS COMMISSION: Councilperson Enyeart asked what the next step is for establishing the park commission. Councilperson Isenberg suggested since Councilperson Houck is chairman of park committee that she set up a meeting with the appointed members. The Commission were supposed to have a budget into the borough October 1st. Councilperson Bair stated that Councilperson Houck should spearhead getting the commission started.

NEW BUSINESS:

ROOF FOR BOROUGH BUILDING: Councilperson Enyeart asked Manager Wheeler if he had any quotes yet. Manager Wheeler responded that next week he is going to sit down and speak with Terry Green. Mr. Green has a lot of experience with

membrane roofing. Councilperson Bair stated that we need to look at some of these trouble spots and see what is causing the problems.

OTHER BUSINESS: Councilperson Enyeart asked if all the playground equipment has been installed. Manager Wheeler reported that one piece has been installed and one not.

Councilperson Decker brought up the subject of keeping the entrance to the cemetery in the plans. He thought we could look into this in the spring.

Councilperson Isenberg asked why there are no trespassing signs on Flag Pole Hill instead of no hunting signs. Manager Wheeler will check into it.
