

PARKS, RECREATION & PUBLIC PROPERTY COMMITTEE MEETING
JUNE 1, 2017
5:00 pm

The following persons were present for the meeting: Chairperson Nicole Houck, Committee member Ron Enyeart and Jim Bair; Councilmembers Donna Isenberg, John Gradwell, and Borough Manager William W. Wheeler.

Chairperson Houck called the meeting to order.

VISITORS: Jennifer Clark

RECOGNIZE GUESTS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Jennifer Clark stated that the sign at the pool states individual membership is \$50.00 and the senior membership is \$60.00. Chairperson Houck stated that is a typo and it will be fixed. Chairperson Houck stated the prices are the same as last year.

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Brown is not present.

OLD BUSINESS:

WEAVER PARK MURAL: Councilperson Houck stated that we will use money from the Borough to purchase the paint for the mural. Councilperson Bair stated that he was hoping for the Weis store to offer to prepare the wall for the mural. Councilperson Bair will get in touch with the representative from the Weis Store.

DOG PARK: Manager Wheeler stated that he is waiting on Solicitor Wilson to get back to him regarding the liability issue. Manager Wheeler will check on a price for a 4 ft. high fence with a gate.

Councilperson Isenberg asked if anyone has looked at the condition of the Bocce Ball Court. Manager Wheeler stated that it is not in great shape. Cory knows that they were supposed to maintain the court.

KAYAK LAUNCH: Manager Wheeler stated that he has to get with Jane Sheffield and see where we are with the money.

STATUS ON ISETT POOL: Chairperson Houck stated that she received an email about coordinating for a picture for the presentation of the check. She gave her availability and never heard back. Manager Wheeler reported that April Feagley, Chet

Isett and David Quarry were there. Councilperson Bair stated that he spoke with Mr. Isett and he was very upset that we had not met with him as yet. Manager Wheeler reported that Mr. Isett had some questions and President Quarry told him that Manager Wheeler was out of town and when he returned he would call him. Manager Wheeler will set up a meeting. Manager Wheeler stated that Kylie is sending an annual report to First National Bank. Councilperson Houck stated that maybe Kristen could send him a monthly report for the summer. Councilperson Bair stated that Mr. Isett would still like to see a kiddy pool. Manager Wheeler explained the last time he wanted to do this he was going to give the borough \$10,000.00. Manager Wheeler reported that \$10,000.00 would not touch the cost of a kiddy pool.

Chairperson Houck stated that she was talking to Mark Colussy regarding grants for playground equipment that would be more assessable. He told her that there are opportunities out there.

Chairperson Houck reported that Ed Tos and his wife both have a lot of grant writing experience and they are willing to volunteer to help.

Manager Wheeler reported that the intern that he spoke of that wanted to intern over the summer does not have any grant writing experience.

Councilperson Isenberg stated that she saw that the summer program at Weaver Park is starting. She asked if anyone has met with them. Manager Wheeler reported that he received a call from Darwin and he stated that the program will begin on Monday. He wanted to get contract people. Manager Wheeler gave himself, Nicole Houck, and Amy Merritts. Manager Wheeler reported that they end the day with the lunch program.

Councilperson Gradwell asked how we can get the wall that has the mosaic art cleaned. Manager Wheeler will look into this.

Councilperson Bair asked if we could rent out the sign that we are using for the 250th celebration. Manager Wheeler will check into this.

Councilperson Decker stated that Blair Field is not kept cleaned up. He thinks we should tell the league that they are responsible for it. Manager Wheeler will check into this.

Councilperson Decker asked if we are doing any paving on the roads up at the cemetery. Manager Wheeler responded that he asked that when John Pecze came to town to do the estimations for all the other roads that he would go to the cemetery and look at those

roads for estimates to be included in the bidding. Manager Wheeler will get with Mr. Pecze.

Manager Wheeler reported that we need to meet Dave Martin regarding the swim meets cost and a set of keys. Manager Wheeler will set up a meeting next week in the afternoon.

Manager Wheeler reported that he is going to have Park's and Carpet One give him a bid to redo tile flooring in the Borough Building. He will be using sheet linoleum.
