

§ 21-604. Violations and Penalties. [Ord. 816, 3/16/2004; as amended by Ord. 858, 3/17/2009]

1. Any person, firm or corporation who shall fail to remove snow or ice from any sidewalk as required by § 21-601, upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not less than \$25. In the event snow or ice is not removed within 48 hours, the fine shall be not less than \$50. In the event snow or ice is not removed within 72 hours, the fine shall be not less than \$75. In the event snow or ice is not removed within 96 hours, the fine shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall deposit snow and/or ice in a traffic lane of a Borough street shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine of not less than \$75 nor more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall remove snow and/or ice from a parking lot and thereafter deposit the snow and/or ice on any portion of a Borough street, including designated street-parking areas, designated no-parking areas, and alleys, shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine of not less than \$75. In the event snow or ice is not removed within 24 hours, the fine shall be not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000, plus costs, and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense. In addition to the above fines and penalties, if, after 24 hours, the snow or ice is not removed, the violator shall be charged to reimburse the Borough for its costs to remove the snow plus 20%. **[Added by Ord. 914, 1/6/2014]**
