PARKS COMMISSION CHAIR'S REPORT: Ed Tos was present to summarize the committee on their last meeting. The Commission decided to keep the fees the same and swimming lessons will be \$75.00. He reported that Dee Dee Brown is soliciting money for scholarships. This will be to pay the daily fee for people who cannot afford it themselves. Mr. Tos stated that the Commission would like to see the entrant's fees and the concession sales kept separate. Manager Wheeler responded that is hard to do. Manager Wheeler responded he had it checked and it is fine. Mr. Tos reported that Chet Isett recommended that Steven Parks looks at the plans for the upgrades to the pool.
