Chris Stevens said we have not heard anything from PennDOT on this.

Chris Stevens spoke on the American Rescue Plan (ARP) and said that our auditor has done a complication figure loss of revenue for us and we can use most of this money for this.

Chris Stevens said we can use the ARP funds to benefit the community, fiber optic for internet, some for the Amphitheater, infrastructure and beautification to bring people to town and businesses.

Chris Stevens said he is working with ZITO on the fiber optic.
