Kevin Nester said if you are in a chemical situation where you would need chemicals to check with other municipalities to borrow until you get chemicals in and then replace it.

Kevin Nester said to talk to Solicitor Richard Wilson on this, but with an emergency, you do not have to bid it out.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens ask Kevin Nester if he has heard about the announcement that the Chesapeake Bay will be in compliance in 2025.

Kevin Nester said he has not heard anything on this.

Chairman David Quarry called on the Borough Manager's report.

Chris Stevens said the guys are doing a great job.

Roger Shaffer said it is nice to have Chris Stevens around that he is more assessable and when he is called he takes his time out and comes over.

Chairman David Quarry called on Old Business.
