Chairman Terry Green called on Old Business.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens ask about this year's street paving and if they had set a date and time to go out and look at the streets.

The Maintenance Committee picked Monday, March 7, 2022 at 9:00 AM for going out.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens said that we know we will be doing Susquehanna Avenue for the bike route and this will be paid from the bike grant we received.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens said that we will be paving the hospital hill on 14th Street.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens said there will be work done downtown, with the PennDOT paving of Penn Street, 200 block of Penn Street water line replacement and we should look at doing the uptown residents areas.

President James Bair said we need to look at 15th Street by the Weis Market and on Oneida Street from 14th to 16th.

Chairman Terry Green called on New Business.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens about having the borough clean up week and mentioned that we had a contract with Hollenbaugh's Trash & Recycling the last couple of years for \$20,000.00 and we didn't have to bid this out.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens said for this year, we need to decide if we want to do curbside again or to have the people bring to us, where some residents do not have trucks or if they do, they cannot load them themselves.

Borough Manager Chris Stevens said if we do curbside we will need to bid this out in May 2022 and make sure the dates are good with the garbage haulers.

The Maintenance Committee was in agreement to have Borough Clean-up Week and to do curbside pickup this year, being able to set items out on April 8th, 9th & 10th, with pickup April 11th thru the 15th.

President James Bair said about posting this on the website, Facebook page and on the front doors if the dates are good.

Executive Session was not called for.

Chairman Terry Green called on Any Other Business.

There was nothing reported under Any Other Business.
